You can also offset the text boxes without overlapping any edges and use the line tool to draw a connecting line between them. Hold the shift key while drawing the line to keep it perfectly straight. After drawing the line, double-click it and choose the same color and weight options you used for your text boxes.

Add an outline to your text boxes by double-clicking the dotted line border of your box, then under the “Line” section of the dialog that opens, choose your color, weight, and other options. Outlines can separate sections of content neatly without distracting from the overall design of the page.

You can add a neat effect by using the same color and weight options for multiple text boxes and arranging them creatively. Overlap one line (either vertical or horizontal) and slightly offset the other.

Zoom in to 200% or 400% to make sure your lines intersect perfectly with your text box outlines.

*All of these boxes and lines can be rearranged, resized or removed to fit your content needs.*
